Access to the hut

You will find several ways to reach the hut.

A From the Räterichsboden reservoir (Grimselstrasse), cross the dam, then follow the well-maintained hiking trail into the Bächlital valley. 600 meters of elevation gain, approx. 2 hours

B There are several alpine passes that connect the Bächlitalhütte with other SAC huts. All passes involve crossing glaciers. Appropriate equipment is required.

- Fellenberglücke to the Lauteraarhütte SAC
- Obere Bächlilücke to the Gaulihütte SAC
- Untere Bächlilücke to the Grubenhütte SAC

Access:

Arrival:

Please check in upon arrival. You will receive initial information, and we will show you your sleeping space.

Breakfast:

We offer breakfast with tea, coffee, milk, bread, butter, jam, cheese, and muesli. An additional 1 liter daily - tea is also provided.

For alpine climbers: by arrangement.

Hut guests: 7:00–8:00 a.m.

Dinner:

Dinner is at 6:30 p.m.

The meal consists of soup, a main course, and dessert.

Vegetarians and those with allergies are welcome to join us if they notify us in advance.

We do not offer vegan options.

Please call us immediately if you will be late for dinner (6:30 p.m.).

Tea & Water:

The hut does not have drinking water!

Dinner is served at 6:30 p.m. Packed tea for the hike will be provided after breakfast. You can fill your own bottle (max. 1 liter).

Hot/cold drinking water must be purchased.

- Packed lunches:** A packed lunch can be ordered the evening before for CHF 15.
- Overnight stay:** 22.00 sleeping time, (T&Cs). by Swiss Alpine Club (SAC) huts.

You will sleep in a Nordic style. A sleeping bag liner is mandatory. Sleeping bags can be rented for CHF 10.
- Slippers:** Slippers are available in the boot room.
- Showers:** Showers are available thanks to ample water.

Next to the hut, you'll find a small lake for swimming!
- Day visitors:** You are very welcome as a day guest! We have a nice menu. Larger groups should announce in advance.
- Dogs:** Dogs are welcome from Monday to Friday. Access to sleeping and common areas is not permitted. Sleeping accommodations will be assigned. We only accept one dog per night. It is absolutely essential to inquire and reserve in advance!

Cancellations up to 48 hours in advance are free of charge; after that, a no-show fee of CHF 70 per person will apply.

Shorter cancellation periods for mountaineers are only possible by prior arrangement with the hut warden!
- Payment:** We prefer cash in Swiss francs (CHF). Euros are also accepted (current exchange rate); debit and credit cards are accepted. (No Postcard)
- General Terms and Conditions:** The Swiss Alpine Club has uniform General Terms and Conditions (GTC) for all huts in Switzerland. We adhere to these rules!
